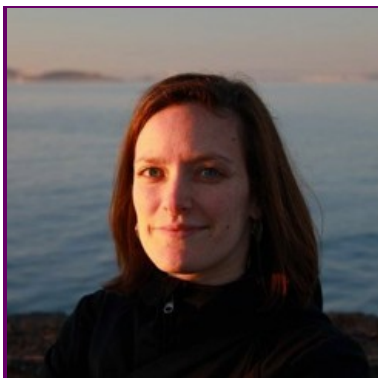


HEATHER BROWN
